

**FOURTH MODIFICATION  
TO THE CHARTER CONTRACT BETWEEN  
THE SCHOOL BOARD OF POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA  
AND BERKLEY CHARTER SCHOOL, INC.**


Pursuant to Section I. B(4) of the Charter Contract between THE SCHOOL BOARD OF POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA, hereinafter Sponsor, and BERKLEY CHARTER SCHOOL, INC., hereinafter School, dated February 13, 2007, this fourth modification to the Charter Contract was presented to and approved by the School Board at its meeting on March 16, 2010 and agreed to by the Berkley Charter School governing board as follows:

Berkley Charter School's projected enrollment for the 2009-2010 school year will be amended to increase the enrollment capacity from 630 students to 673 students for the 2009-2010 school year and attached hereto is agreed upon by the Sponsor and the School and is incorporated into the Charter Contract effective as of March 16, 2010.

All other provisions of the Charter Contract shall remain in full force and effect.



Dear School Board Members:

I would like to request approval for an increase in Berkley Charter School's student enrollment to 673. Our current enrollment is 630 students. Berkley's newly constructed ten classroom wing was completed and passed inspection on January 14, 2010. We will be occupying the building on February 5. We need to add 43 students from our waiting list to fill all 10 classrooms.

I am requesting to enroll the 43 students that are currently on our waiting in list in fourth and fifth grades on March 19, 2010. This date is after FCAT testing. There is a concern voiced by principals that these students be tested at their schools in order to be included in their schools' testing data. March 19 is also Berkley Accelerated Middle School's last day for open enrollment. The parents of these fifth grade students wish to receive priority in BAMS sixth grade enrollment for the following school year. They will have priority if they are currently a Berkley Charter School student.
