

## APPENDIX 9

### ENROLLMENT PLAN

#### RIDGEVIEW GLOBAL STUDIES ACADEMY

Since F.S. 1002.33, (7) (a) 8 states: "The ways by which the school will achieve a racial/ethnic balance reflective of the community it serves or within the racial/ethnic range of other public schools in the same district," Ridgeview Global Studies Academy will achieve a racial/ethnic balance within the racial/ethnic range of other public schools in the same district. This range will be based upon all schools in the district. Ridgeview currently has the following percentages: White – 37%, Black – 17%, Hispanic – 35%, Other 11%; F/R – 56%; ESE – 12%; and ELL – 22%.

The ways by which this will be achieved are as follows as outlined in F.S.1002.33 (10) ELIGIBLE STUDENTS:

- (a) Ridgeview Academy shall be open to any student covered in an interdistrict agreement or residing in the school district in which the charter school is located.
- (b) Ridgeview Academy shall enroll an eligible student who submits a timely application, unless the number of applications exceeds the capacity of a program, class, grade level, or building. In such case, all applicants shall have an equal chance of being admitted through a random selection process.
- (c) Since Ridgeview Academy is a conversion charter school, the primary community to be served by this charter school is the Davenport/Four Corners area of Polk County which includes the students who would have otherwise attended the School prior to its conversion to a Charter School and who live north of I-4 in the area, which is currently zoned for transportation for Ridgeview Global Studies Academy.
- (d) Enrollment priority shall be as follows:
  1. Child(ren) of an employee
  2. Child(ren) of a governing board member
  3. Pre-kindergarten enrolled students
  4. Siblings of students enrolled in the school
  5. Students who would have otherwise attended the School prior to the School's conversion to a Charter School and who live north of I-4 in the area, which is currently zoned for transportation for Ridgeview Global Studies Academy.

In the event it is determined that Ridgeview Global Studies Academy's racial/ethnic percentages do not fall within the range of other public schools in the same district, the School will submit an Action Plan and timetable for implementation that brings the School back into compliance with F.S. 1002.33 (7)(a)8.
