

# Introducing Medco's Extended Payment Program

## Paying for your mail-order prescriptions just got easier

Medco has created a program to help make your mail-order prescriptions more affordable. It's called the Extended Payment Program (EPP).

EPP allows you to spread your prescription payments over **three** credit or debit card installments so you don't have to pay all at once. And there's no waiting—your medication will be shipped after the very first payment.

When you're enrolled in EPP it will apply to every mail-order prescription for you and your eligible dependents going forward. If at any point you wish to opt out of the program, you may call Member Services or visit [medco.com](http://medco.com).

### How EPP works

Below is an example of how EPP can make your prescriptions more affordable.

Member cost for medication	\$90.00
Service fee (5% APR)	\$0.38
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$90.38</b>
<b>How it's divided:</b>	
Payment 1 Paid at time of order; all medication shipped at this time	\$30.00
Payment 2 Paid in 30 days and includes portion of service fee	\$30.25
Payment 3 Paid in 60 days and includes portion of service fee	\$30.13
<b>Total of 3 payments</b>	<b>\$90.38</b>

### Facts about EPP

- A service fee of 5% annual percentage rate, or APR will apply. This will be charged to your second and third payment.
- If you decide to cancel EPP at anytime, payment for the remainder of your current prescriptions will be your responsibility.
- If the payment plan ends, invoices incurred while enrolled in EPP will continue to be charged in three installments. New invoices will require your regular co-payments in full.
