

How & Why To Create Screen Shots For Fast ForWord Motivation & Intervention

First of all, why take a screen shot?

- ❑ To capture a specific exercise, bonus round, or part of an exercise to refer to when intervening, coaching or motivating your students.
- ❑ To create an "instant bulletin board" for motivational purposes within a given FFW product.
- ❑ To capture progress within the Success Viewer.
- ❑ The possibilities are endless!

How do I take a screen shot of the current window on my computer?

On Windows:

You can take a picture of the current window by pressing *Prt Scn/SysReq* key. It will copy the window to the clipboard, so you can paste it wherever you want. Simply open a Word document and choose Edit/paste.

On a Mac:

You can press Command-Shift-3 to take a picture of the entire screen or Command-Shift-4 to take a picture of whatever area you select with the mouse. The picture will be created and saved on your primary hard disk. To print the image, simply open the document.
