

## Final Cut Pro Chroma Key Instructions

1. Open the Log and Capture window. (File>Log and Capture)
2. Under the Capture settings tab, change to non-controllable device.
3. Capture your anchor team footage.
4. Press escape when footage is complete.
5. Drag your captured footage of the anchors to video track 2.
6. Import your background or footage into FCP. (File>Import File)
7. Drag your background image or footage to video track 1.
8. Double click your footage on video track 2, which will display in the viewer.
9. From the FCP menu, choose (Effects> video filters> Key> chroma keyer).
10. Select the chroma key tab from the viewer window.
11. Choose the eye dropper tool from the tool palette to select the green or blue area in the canvas window.
12. Adjust the saturation and color box to your desired look (or key level).
13. Click back on the video tab in the viewer window to finalize.
14. Render your project.
15. Save your project!
