

# **New** Florida Law Requires **FAFSA** for Bright Futures Scholarship Disbursement

- Students must submit a complete and error free **FAFSA before Bright Futures funds can be disbursed** – college freshmen, sophomores, juniors, seniors
- Demonstration of need **not** required
