

**6Gx53-1.005 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES RULES:**

The Administrative Procedure Act as set forth in Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, shall govern the following proceedings:

I. Rulemaking and Adoption Procedures: The rulemaking and adoption procedures set forth in the Administrative Procedure Act shall apply whenever the proceedings involve the adoption, amendment, or repeal of any rule.

II. Decisions Which Affect Substantial Interests:

A. Formal Proceedings: Unless waived by all parties, the formal proceedings set forth in the Administrative Procedure Act shall apply whenever the proceedings involve a disputed issue of material fact.

B. Informal Proceedings: Unless otherwise agreed, the informal proceedings set forth in the Administrative Procedures Act shall apply in all other cases.
