

**6Gx53-1.010 SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS:**

I. Purpose and Intent of Policy: Pursuant to Florida's System of School Improvement and Accountability (formerly Blueprint 2000) established by the 1991 Florida Legislature, The School Board of Polk County, Florida, has promulgated and adopted this policy for the purpose of establishing procedures for carrying out a system of school improvement and accountability, including the establishment, maintenance, and involvement of school advisory councils, for the school district.

II. School Improvement Plan and School Advisory Council Statutes: Florida Statutes 1001.452, 1008.345, 1001.42, including any amendments thereto, are incorporated herein by reference and shall supersede any provisions in this policy with are inconsistent therewith.

III. School Improvement Plans and Reports: Each regularly designated school shall develop annually a school improvement plan using the designated district format and planning procedures and shall report progress annually on the achievement of this plan using district formats and timeliness.
