

**6Gx53-4.006 STUDENT PROGRESSION PLAN:**

The School Board of Polk County, Florida has implemented a Board-approved comprehensive program for student progression which is based on an evaluation of each student's performance, including how well the student masters the minimum performance standards approved by the State Board.

I. Basic Skills: Particular emphasis is placed on the student's mastery of the basic skills, especially reading, before the student is promoted from grade level to grade level. Procedures established in the comprehensive program are to be used for the remediation of those students who are unable to meet such standards.

II. Other Factors: Other pertinent factors considered by the teacher before recommending to the principal that a student progress from one grade level to another shall be age, social development, interests and aptitudes (art, music, etc.), strengths and weaknesses in basic academic areas, positive attitude, and willingness to work.
