

6Gx53-4.012 SPECIAL PROGRAMS:

I. Procedures and Guidelines: All special instructional programs, regardless of funding source, shall operate within the guidelines and procedures as established by the School Board for the Division of Instructional Services and the Division of Vocational, Adult and Community Education.

II. Summer Programs: The Summer Academic School and Summer Enrichment Program shall be approved by the School Board annually.

III. Vocational-Technical Centers: The Vocational Technical Centers' roles are to make available the opportunities to learn the necessary skills for a given trade or business. Upon completion of training, persons should demonstrate competency achievement at a level required for the occupational field.

Operational policies and procedures are in accordance with those established by the School Board of Polk County, Florida.

IV. Exceptional Student Education Program: As required in Florida Statute 1001.42, Vocational Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Polk County shall provide a free appropriate program of special instruction for all exceptional students. In compliance with Florida Statute 1001.42 the School Board will submit annually to the Department of Education its proposed Exceptional Student Special Programs and Procedures Document, which is written in compliance with all state and federal rules and regulations governing exceptional students.
