SUBJECT: 2010/11 September Budget Amendments – 11/16/10 Board Meeting

In an effort to assist in better understanding the changes in our budgets for September 7, 2010 through September 30, 2010, I have prepared the following summary:

General Fund: Revenue and corresponding appropriations were recorded for various donations and recycling receipts. Incoming transfers were increased for PECO (SSM/SAF) Maintenance and for LCI funding of the Don Woods media center collection. Fund balance decreased due to appropriations from fund balance made for maintenance/repair projects previously approved by the board, and additional prior year appropriation carryovers posted during September. Various routine transfers were made to reclassify expenditure budgets appropriately based upon actual needs and proper function.

Debt Service Funds: No amendment necessary.

Capital Projects Funds: Additional PECO maintenance revenue and interest earned YTD were budgeted. Outgoing transfers were increased for PECO (SSM/SAF) Maintenance and for LCI funding of the Don Woods media center collection. Fund balance was appropriated to projects previously approved by the board.

Special Revenue Fund (Food Service): No amendment necessary.

Special Revenue Fund (Other-Grants): Additional revenue and corresponding appropriations were recorded for various Learn & Serve grant awards previously approved by the board. Various routine transfers were made to reclassify revenue and expenditure budgets appropriately based upon actual needs and proper function.

Special Revenue Fund (ARRA): ARRA revenue and corresponding appropriations were increased to reflect the award of ARRA Title I School Improvement Part G funds for Oscar J. Pope Elementary.

Internal Service Funds: No amendment necessary.
