

# Spatial Organization

- To use margins – highlight left margin green and right margin red to signal Go and Stop.
- Provide the child with alternatively written math pages or math problems so that their assignments are written in a vertical arrangement, not horizontal. This strategy is especially beneficial for groupings when being introduced to multiplication and division concepts as well as those problems which require regrouping or borrowing procedures.
- Cue the child to number words, sentences, and math problems on the outside of the left margin to avoid confusion of numbers and improve legibility. Use a Wikki Stix if desired.

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- Continue to provide narrow strips of paper to discourage upside-down and side-ways handwriting.
- When standard writing paper is used, have the child write on every other line.
- Try a highlighted base line to see if this visual strategy cues better alignment of letters to the line.
