Snively Elementary School of Choice is located in Eloise, Florida. In 1948, the new "Eloise School" was built on a 10-acre site donated to the Polk County School Board by John A. Snively, a prominent citrus grower in Polk County. In 1959, after the addition of new classroom wings, the school was renamed in his honor. The school opened as a Choice school in 2000.
