REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS FOR SCHOOL ENTRY

Your child must receive all of the required immunizations (shots) to attend school in Florida. If your child does not have all of the required shots, you must arrange for your child to receive the remaining ones.

You should contact your child's health care provider to receive the immunizations. You may also call the Florida Department of Health in Polk County clinic nearest you to have your child immunized. You will need to call for days and times when immunizations are available. The Florida Department of Health in Polk County also has a traveling immunization team that travels between Haines City and Lake Wales. Immunizations are available at the following locations:

- When going to a clinic for vaccinations, take your child with you and a copy of his or her previous immunizations.
- A permanent immunization certificate cannot be issued to you without a completed shot record.
