

At the PLC - Looking at last year's data for Grades 3-10 and 11(Science)

What is needed? (Can be displayed on a computer screen, projected, or hard copied.)

Teachers Grades 3-10 and 11(Science) will need:

- Polk FCAT Trends.pdf (includes **all** students tested)
 - located in Outlook>public folders>Assessment, Accountability and Evaluation>2009 Data Day> Polk FCAT Trends.pdf
- (School name) FCAT Trends.pdf (includes **all** students tested at school) – located in Outlook (see above)
- School Grade Level Details for the school (includes **ONLY** students present for October and February FTE that tested)
 - located in Outlook (see above) as (school name) Grade Level RC.pdf

Teachers Grades K – 2 - will need reports located in Outlook (see above)

- SAT10 by grade level (also SESAT2 where applicable)
- DIBELS (if available at the school)

What is to be done?

Teachers Grades 3-10 and 11(Science) will:

- Examine and compare the Polk FCAT Trends and the School FCAT Trends for the selected area (reading, math, writing, or science) and selected grade/ department/ discipline or team using the Guide Questions
 - located in Outlook>public folders>Assessment, Accountability and Evaluation>2009 Data Day>Guide Questions
- Compare these results with the results in the School Grade Level Details Report for:
 - Percent meeting High Standards
 - Percent making Learning Gains
 - Percent of lowest 25% making Learning Gains

Teachers Grades K – 2 will:

- Examine and compare last year's and the previous year's SAT10 in reading/math.

- See Guide Questions located in Outlook>public folders>Assessment, Accountability and Evaluation>2009 Data Day>Guide Questions.
- Compare these results with last year's DIBELS data (if available at the school) to determine if the results were consistent.

What is the Final Product?

Each **PLC** (grade/department/discipline or team) should prepare and email their Principal a short bulleted list of their findings and recommendations for future actions. Please list the names of the persons in the PLC. This is to be completed by September 18th.
