

SAC - Continuous Improvement Model

Eight Step Process Overview

1. Plan - Data Disaggregation:

Create a vision; use data to identify areas for improvement (student groups, teacher teams, academic teams).

2. Plan - Calendar Development:

Build an instructional calendar that includes all standards assessed, additional time for areas where students are having trouble; allow for adjustments necessary to cover a target area.

3. Do - Instructional Focus:

Ensure that classroom activities are focused and conducive to learning through direct instruction of the Sunshine State Standards.

4. Check - Assessment:

Administered frequently and integrated into the curriculum and instruction; Teacher teams meet frequently to create assessments and review the results.

5. Check - Maintenance:

Reinforce skills and knowledge that are taught until they become a permanent part of the student's knowledge base.

6. Check - Monitoring:

School principal assumes primary responsibility for monitoring program success by regularly visiting classrooms, meet with teachers and students to review test scores and organizes celebrations for achievements.

7. Act - Tutorials:

Re-teach Sunshine State Standards that students did not master.

8. Act - Enrichment:

Extend learning activities planned for students that have mastered specific Sunshine State Standards.
