Who is eligible?

Any PreK - 8th grade teacher that teaches math, science, social studies, or language arts and has attended the 2009 IDEA Expo or has made contact with a specific developer. This includes Speech, ALPHA, ESE, Guidance, Music, P.E. and Media Specialists educators. Teachers may choose only one Developer's program to adapt for funding. One application per teacher please.

PLEASE NOTE: Depending on the number of Adapter Grant applicants and available funding, it may become necessary to give priority to applicants that have received less than 1-2 Adapter Grants in the past.

How much money is available?

Applicants may apply for up to \$200 needed to adapt the program. Team recipients must split the grant money.

Accountability

If chosen as an Adapter Grant recipient, I understand that all grant funds must be spent on program-appropriate classroom materials by an assigned deadline, and the receipts turned in for all materials purchased. Any money not spent must be returned to the Foundation. I must also complete a final report and will allow the Developer or P.E.F. staff member to come observe what I have done to adapt this program. My name and picture may be used for P.E.F. publications. I agree to meet the above stated conditions or forfeit my Adapter Grant.
