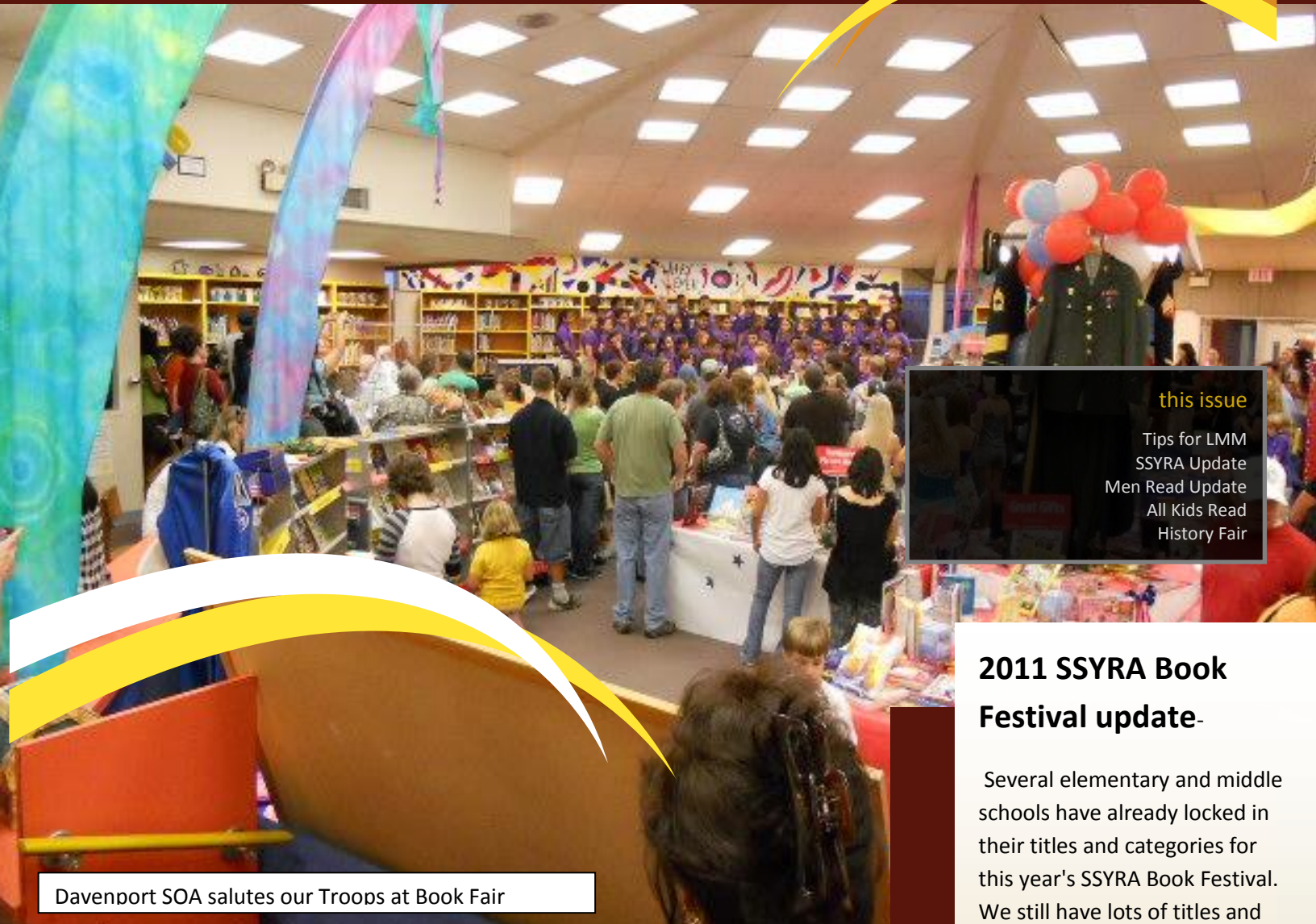

Tips for preparing your LMM orders

- Make sure you use the correct Cost Center
- Purchase Orders to Outside Vendors:

If you are submitting requisitions for items that could have a delivery time frame during the upcoming holidays, please include the following language on your requisitions:

Note to Vendor: Please do not deliver items from MM/DD/YY through MM/DD/YY. No one will be available to accept deliveries during this time.

Please include this information in the "Delivery Text" section for line item one on the requisition.

- If you have a list, make sure to send a copy with the requisition # written on the top to purchasing and Janice Hayes. Also keep a copy of the list for your files.

- **DO NOT EXCEED YOUR ALLOCATION AMOUNT.** Orders that go over will have items deleted until the amount is correct.

Tips for History Fair

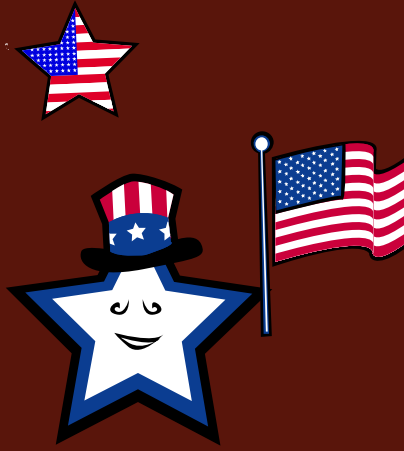
If students at your school are participating in this year's History Fair be sure to share these sites and resources with them and their teachers:

November 11th is Veterans' Day

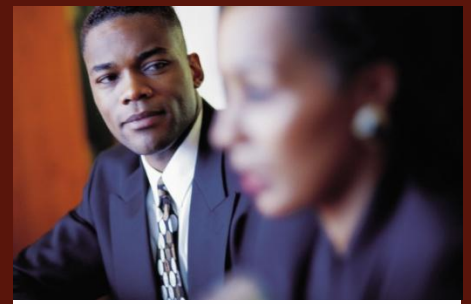
Celebrate Veterans at your school whether they are teachers, parents, grandparents, staff. Let them know how much they are appreciated!
