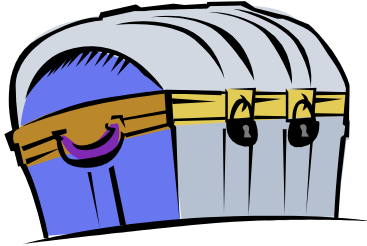


“Founding a Colony”
