

2010 App Drive Steps



Instructional Television

The application drive is split up into two partitions of the Firelite. These partitions allow you to install a fresh copy of Mac OSX 10.6 Snow Leopard. Important note: Snow Leopard can ONLY be installed on an Intel computer.

Overall Process

1. Backup any important files
2. Format/wipe computer
3. Install Mac OSX 10.6 Snow Leopard
4. Install preliminary updates
5. Install needed applications
6. Finish with multiple software updates

Initial Setup

Note: This process will erase ALL data from your computer's hard drive. It is recommended to save any important files to another drive for safekeeping.

1. Connect the 2010 OS/Application drive to the computer via firewire.
2. Shut down the computer if it is already on.
3. Turn the computer on while holding down the ALT key.
4. A menu will appear showing your computer's hard drive (usually labeled Macintosh HD with a normal grey hard drive icon), and the OS partition on the firelite (appears as a yellow firewire drive).
5. Select the Mac OSX drive and click the arrow. This will launch the Mac OSX Installer

Format/Wipe Computer

1. Select **English** as the main language and click continue arrow.
2. Go to **Utilities > Disk Utility**.
3. Select the **non-indented Macintosh HD** in the left pane. Do not click any part of the yellow application drive.
4. Select the **Partitions** tab.
5. Use the dropdown menu under **Volume Scheme** to select **1**.
6. Click the **Options** button.
7. Select the top option, **GUID Partition Table**, and click **Apply**.
8. In the name field, type in: **Macintosh HD**.
9. Click the **Partition** button.
10. Once the partition is complete, go to **Disk Utility > Quit Disk Utility**.

Install Mac OSX 10.6 Snow Leopard

1. Click Continue.
2. Accept the license agreement
3. Select your Macintosh HD drive.
4. Click Customize.
5. Make sure **ONLY** these options are checked. All other options should be unchecked:
 - a. Rosetta
 - b. Quicktime 7
6. Click Continue to install. The computer will restart once finished.

7. After the reboot, the installer will go through its Setup Assistant.
8. Most of these screens are self-explanatory and can be filled out by yourself.
 - a. Note: When asked about Network setup, choose Local Area Network.

Preliminary Updates

In order to install some of the applications that ITV uses, your operating system should be at least 10.6.2.

1. Double-click the **Applications** drive.
2. Double-click the **Misc** folder. There are two update packages in this folder: one for Leopard (Mac OSX 10.5) and one for Snow Leopard (Mac OSX 10.6). Double-click the **Snow Leopard version** (filenames might be different from applications drive to applications drive).
3. Follow the on screen instructions to install the update.
4. Restart the computer.

Install Needed Applications

Installing the applications can be somewhat automated. You can have multiple installations going at a time. Below is generally one of the best ways to “automate” this process.

1. **Final Cut Pro**
 - a. Open the **Final Cut Studio 3** folder
 - b. Highlight all of the disk image files
 - c. Go to **File > Open**. All of the disk images will mount on the desktop.
 - d. Find and open the “**Install Final Cut Studio**” package.
 - e. Follow the on-screen instructions.
 - f. When asked for a serial number: F-349-TM4-474-MX4-155-EWB-111-RWJ-1BZ-X37B
 - g. Once installation begins, you can move on to another program.
2. **Remote Desktop**
 - a. Open the **Application Drive > Remote Desktop Client** folder.
 - b. Double-click the “RemoteClient-SL” package.
 - c. Follow the on-screen instructions.
 - d. Once you get to the point where it says “Waiting for other installations to finish,” move on to another program.
3. **Microsoft Office 2008**
 - a. Open the **Application Drive > Microsoft Office 2008** folder.
 - b. Double-click the “**Microsoft Office 2008**” package.
 - c. Follow the on-screen instructions.
 - d. Once you get to the point where it says “Waiting for other installations to finish,” move on to another program.
4. **iLife 09**
 - a. Open the **Application Drive > iLife '09** folder.
 - b. Double-click the “**iLife '09**” package.
 - c. Follow the on-screen instructions.

- d. Once this installation is finished, restart the computer.
- 5. Photoshop CS2**
- a. Open the **Application Drive > Photoshop** folder.
 - b. Double-click the **“Adobe Photoshop CS2”** package.
 - c. Follow the on-screen instructions.
 - d. When asked for a serial: 1045-0413-8848-7627-7338-0370

Setting up the Dock

1. Open the **Macintosh HD > Applications** folder.
2. Drag each of the applications to the dock so you may have quick and easy access to them.

Checking Installations

Most of the applications should install correctly, however, every now-and-then the Motion installer will skip over installing the templates. Here’s how to check and fix.

1. Open **Motion**.
2. Select **“Open with Template.”** If there are no templates visible, we need to install them.
3. Open the **“Motion Content 1”** disk image on the desktop.
4. Double-click the **“Install Motion Content”** package.
5. Follow the on-screen instructions.
6. Once complete, repeat steps 1 through 2 for the templates.

Update Software

Now the applications need to be updated to their current versions.

Setup Proxies

1. Go to **Apple > System Preferences**.
2. Click **Network**.
3. Click **Ethernet 1**.
4. Click **Advanced**.
5. Click the **Proxies** tab.
6. Check the **“Secure Web Proxy (HTTPS)”**.
7. Now click on the actual words **“Secure Web Proxy (HTTPS)”** to be able to type in the textbox.
8. Input: **204.122.254.9** for the proxy and **2804** for the port.
9. Click Apply until the windows are gone.

Software Update

1. Go to **Apple > Software Update**.
2. Make sure everything is checked and click install.
3. Make sure to rerun the Software Update program as many times as it takes until it reports **“All products are up to date.”**
