The DOE Inventory of Teacher Technology Skills is a set of measurable indicators for basic technology designed as a tool for assessing teacher technology skills. The Florida Department of Education has produced this inventory which forms the basis for an objective assessment tool. This tool has been offered to all districts to assist with addressing NCLB literacy goals. School Technology Services plans to use this assessment to determine the technology proficiency of its educators.

Successful passing of the inventory meets requirements for Teacher Technology Proficiency Levels I and/or II.

A passing score of 80% in each of the six areas is required.
