

All America Team Judge **Information & Guide**

An *All America Team* judge's choices are very important to six of the players at the end of the opening two rounds of competition. The one player in each of six geographic regions with the highest score is named to the All America Team and receives a \$1,000 scholarship and a medallion. Your assistance in this scoring process is important and appreciated. The ranking by the AA judges is the subjective portion of the total score, and there are three AA judges in each competition room.

1. Choose one person from *every* team, even if the team never answers a single question.
2. Consider the following when making your choices:
 - Role as a team player
 - Overall performance
 - Sportsman-like demeanor
 - Academic prowess
 - Performed best in YOUR opinion
3. During competition, make notes to identify players and verify the identities of players with the RE (Regional Evaluator, the AA scorer) during breaks using playing position, clothing and descriptions.
4. Ask the Coordinating Judge to get verification of identity of players before competition ends if still unsure.
5. Rank your choices from 1 to X with 1 being the highest and X being the number of teams competing.
6. **PRINT** your name, indicate the round number and competition room, and sign your form. This is important, as you may need to be consulted regarding your observations.
7. Turn in your ranking form to the RE (Regional Evaluator, the AA scorer) in your room *before* leaving the competition room.
