

Executive Summary

of the Follow-up Survey of Polk County Public School's Class of 2001

2085 of the 3492 graduates in the class of 2001 were contacted during this telephone survey
A contact rate of 59.71% 19 schools are represented in the survey

58.66% (1223) are employed either full-time or part-time
28.15% (587) are employed full-time **30.50%** (636) are employed part-time
64.41% (1343) are enrolled in a post-secondary program
5.80% (121) are enlisted in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)
3.12% (65) indicated they had already completed a post-secondary program

22.21% (463) employed ONLY
 18.56% (387) employed full-time ONLY 3.65% (76) employed part-time ONLY
4.22% (88) in the military ONLY (Active, Reserves or National Guard)
28.15% (587) enrolled in a post-secondary school ONLY
 0.53% (11) had completed a post-secondary program ONLY
 0.34% (7) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program
 0.62% (13) employed and in the military
35.30% (736) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program
 0.53% (11) enrolled in post-secondary program and in the military
 0.43% (9) enrolled in a post-secondary program and in the military and employed
 3.02% (63) had been employed, enrolled, or in the military, but were NOT when surveyed
 4.70% (98) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or in the military

74.34% (1550) were in VOCATIONAL programs - Tech Prep (TP) in 2000/2001 and/or had achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP).

Of the responding 1550 graduates who were in a VOCATIONAL program

24.00% (372) employed
 19.94% (309) employed full-time 4.06% (63) employed part-time
4.65% (72) in the military (active, Reserves, or National Guard)
25.35% (393) enrolled in post-secondary program
 0.58% (9) had completed a post-secondary program
 0.26% (4) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program
 0.65% (10) employed and in the military
36.26% (562) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program
 0.58% (9) enrolled in a post-secondary program and in the military
 0.39% (6) enrolled in a post-secondary program and in the military and employed
 2.77% (43) had been employed, enrolled or in the military, but were NOT when surveyed
 2.13% (33) did not respond to being employed, enrolled, or in the military

25.66% (535) were NON-VOCATIONAL students - NOT in Tech Prep (TP) in 2000/2001 and/or had NOT achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP)

Of the responding 535 graduates who were NOT in a vocational program

17.01% (91) employed
 14.58% (78) employed full-time 2.43% (13) employed part-time
2.99% (16) in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)
36.26% (194) enrolled in post-secondary program
 0.37% (2) had completed a post-secondary program
 0.56% (3) had completed a post-secondary program and was enrolled in another post-secondary program
 0.56% (3) employed and in the military
32.52% (174) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program
 0.37% (2) were enrolled in post secondary schooling and in the military.
 0.56% (3) enrolled in a post-secondary program and in the military and employed
 3.74% (20) had been employed, enrolled or in the military, but were NOT when surveyed
 1.87% (10) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or in the military.
