

# Executive Summary

## of the Follow-up Survey of Polk County Public Schools' Class of 2002

2922 of the 4027 graduates in the class of 2002 were contacted during this telephone survey  
A contact rate of 72.56% 20 schools are represented in the survey

<b>61.77%</b>	<b>(1805) are EMPLOYED either full-time or part-time</b>
	<b>32.68% (955) are employed FULL-time 29.09% (850) are employed PART-time</b>
<b>60.37%</b>	<b>(1764) are ENROLLED in a post-secondary program</b>
<b>5.34%</b>	<b>(156) are ENLISTED in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)</b>
<b>2.87%</b>	<b>(84) indicated they had already COMPLETED a post-secondary program</b>

26.83% (784) employed ONLY

22.96% (671) employed full-time ONLY 3.87% (113) employed part-time ONLY

4.55% (133) enlisted in the military ONLY (Active, Reserves or National Guard)

25.15% (735) enrolled in a post-secondary school ONLY

0.51% (15) had completed a post-secondary program ONLY

0.24% (7) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program

0.14% (4) employed and enlisted in the military

34.80% (1017) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program

0.41% (12) enrolled in post-secondary program and enlisted in the military

0.24% (7) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military

2.77% (81) had been employed, enrolled, or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed

3.59% (105) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military

76.15% (2225 ) were in VOCATIONAL programs - Tech Prep (TP) in 2001/2002 and/or had achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP).

Of the responding 2225 graduates who were in a VOCATIONAL program

27.24% (606) employed

23.46% (522) employed full-time 3.78% (84) employed part-time

4.85% (108) enlisted in the military (active, Reserves, or National Guard)

24.54% (546) enrolled in post-secondary program

0.45% (10) had completed a post-secondary program

0.27% (6) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program

0.09% (2) employed and enlisted in the military

35.37% (787) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program

0.27% (6) enrolled in a post-secondary program and enlisted in the military

0.22% (5) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military

2.79% (62) had been employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed

3.01% (67) did not respond to being employed, enrolled, or enlisted in the military

23.85% (697) were NON-VOCATIONAL students - NOT in Tech Prep (TP) in 2001/2002 and/or had NOT achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP)

Of the responding 697 graduates who were NOT in a vocational program

25.54% (178) employed

21.38% (149) employed full-time 4.16% (29) employed part-time

3.59% (25) enlisted in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)

27.12% (189) enrolled in post-secondary program

0.72% (5) had completed a post-secondary program

0.14% (1) had completed a post-secondary program and was enrolled in another post-secondary program

0.29% (2) employed and enlisted in the military

33.00% (230) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program

0.86% (6) were enrolled in post secondary schooling and enlisted in the military.

0.29% (2) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military

2.73% (19) had been employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed

5.74% (40) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military.
