

Executive Summary

of the Follow-up Survey of Polk County Public Schools' Class of 2003

2553 of the 3789 graduates in this class were contacted during this telephone survey
A contact rate of : 67.38% 20 schools are represented in the survey

63.65% (1625) are EMPLOYED either full-time or part-time
30.67% (783) are employed FULL-time **32.98%** (842) are employed PART-time
63.49% (1621) are ENROLLED in a post-secondary program
4.35% (111) are ENLISTED in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)
3.17% (81) indicated they had already COMPLETED a post-secondary program

26.48% (676) employed ONLY
 21.86% (558) employed full-time ONLY 4.62% (118) employed part-time ONLY
3.96% (101) enlisted in the military ONLY (Active, Reserves or National Guard)
26.17% (668) enrolled in a post-secondary school ONLY
 0.43% (11) had completed a post-secondary program ONLY
 0.12% (3) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program
 0.08% (2) employed and enlisted in the military
37.09% (947) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program
 0.24% (6) enrolled in post-secondary program and enlisted in the military
 0.08% (2) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military
 1.61% (41) had been employed, enrolled, or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed
 3.21% (82) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military

The figures below reflect those graduates involved in that activity exclusively.

78.42% (2002) were in VOCATIONAL programs - Tech Prep (TP) in 2002/2003 and/or had achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP).

Of the responding 2002 graduates who were in a VOCATIONAL program

29.72% (595) employed
 24.88% (498) employed full-time 4.85% (97) employed part-time
3.60% (72) enlisted in the military (active, Reserves, or National Guard)
23.63% (473) enrolled in post-secondary program
 0.50% (10) had completed a post-secondary program
 0.10% (2) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program
 0.10% (2) employed and enlisted in the military
36.01% (721) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program
 0.15% (3) enrolled in a post-secondary program and enlisted in the military
 0.10% (2) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military
 1.90% (38) had been employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed
 3.85% (77) did not respond to being employed, enrolled, or enlisted in the military

21.58% (551) were NON-VOCATIONAL students - NOT in Tech Prep (TP) in 2002/2003 and/or had NOT achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP)

Of the responding 551 graduates who were NOT in a vocational program

14.70% (81) employed
 10.89% (60) employed full-time 3.81% (21) employed part-time
5.26% (29) enlisted in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)
35.39% (195) enrolled in post-secondary program
 0.18% (1) had completed a post-secondary program
 0.18% (1) had completed a post-secondary program and was enrolled in another post-secondary program
 0.00% (0) employed and enlisted in the military
41.02% (226) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program
 0.54% (3) were enrolled in post secondary schooling and enlisted in the military.
 0.00% (0) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military
 0.54% (3) had been employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed
 2.18% (12) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military.
