

Executive Summary

of the Follow-up Survey of Polk County Public Schools' Class of 2004

2501 of the 4480 graduates in this class were contacted during this telephone survey

A contact rate of: 55.83%

22 schools are represented in the survey

63.05% (1577) are EMPLOYED either full-time or part-time
36.11% (903) are employed FULL-time **26.95%** (674) are employed PART-time
59.54% (1489) are ENROLLED in a post-secondary program
3.52% (88) are ENLISTED in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)
3.16% (79) indicated they had already COMPLETED a post-secondary program

30.31% (758) employed ONLY

26.63% (666) employed full-time ONLY 3.68% (92) employed part-time ONLY

3.12% (78) enlisted in the military ONLY (Active, Reserves or National Guard)

26.67% (667) enrolled in a post-secondary school ONLY

0.24% (6) had completed a post-secondary program ONLY

0.44% (11) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program

0.08% (2) employed and enlisted in the military

32.67% (817) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program

0.20% (5) enrolled in post-secondary program and enlisted in the military

0.08% (2) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military

3.08% (77) had been employed, enrolled, or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed

3.04% (76) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military

The figures below reflect those graduates involved in that activity exclusively.

68.37% (1710) were in VOCATIONAL programs - Tech Prep (TP) in 2002/2003 and/or had achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP).

Of the responding 1710 graduates who were in a VOCATIONAL program

34.97% (598) employed

30.88% (528) employed full-time 4.09% (70) employed part-time

3.16% (54) enlisted in the military (active, Reserves, or National Guard)

23.57% (403) enrolled in post-secondary program

0.29% (5) had completed a post-secondary program

0.41% (7) had completed a post-secondary program and enrolled in another post-secondary program

0.06% (1) employed and enlisted in the military

30.00% (513) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program

0.12% (2) enrolled in a post-secondary program and enlisted in the military

0.06% (1) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military

3.39% (58) had been employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed

4.15% (71) did not respond to being employed, enrolled, or enlisted in the military

31.63% (791) were NON-VOCATIONAL students - NOT in Tech Prep (TP) in 2002/2003 and/or had NOT achieved at least one Occupational Completion Point (OCP)

Of the responding 791 graduates who were NOT in a vocational program

20.23% (160) employed

17.45% (138) employed full-time 2.78% (22) employed part-time

3.03% (24) enlisted in the military (active, Reserves or National Guard)

33.38% (264) enrolled in post-secondary program

0.13% (1) had completed a post-secondary program

0.51% (4) had completed a post-secondary program and was enrolled in another post-secondary program

0.13% (1) employed and enlisted in the military

38.43% (304) employed and enrolled in a post-secondary program

0.38% (3) were enrolled in post secondary schooling and enlisted in the military.

0.13% (1) enrolled in a post-secondary program and employed and enlisted in the military

2.40% (19) had been employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military, but were NOT when surveyed

1.52% (12) did not respond to being employed, enrolled or enlisted in the military.
